Language Area

This month's Chinese sounds are 《 万广 中 (ge, ke, he, ji). We will read the Chinese poem. 江雪 (Jiang Hsueh). Older children will continue sounding out words and working on strokes. In the English classroom, this month's sounds are Ii, Tt, Zz, and Pp. Children may bring objects that start with these sounds to share. 

Math Area

This month, we will be learning the numbers zero through nine using Sandpaper Numbers. The students will also practice tracing numbers and lines. Our older children will begin working with Teen Boards, Ten Boards, and Fraction Skittles, and will work with this month's calendar and fractions.
