Language Area

We are starting a new year and will start with ㄅ ㄆ ㄇ and ㄘ (Bo, Po, Mo, and Fo). We will read the Chinese poem 三字經 (San Dz Jin) lesson 1, 詠鵝 (Young Er) and Chinese character strokes and tracing. The English classroom will work with the sounds for Aa, Bb, Cc, and Dd. For the older children, we will be working on the pink area sounding out 3 letter words. The English poem is Baa Baa Black Sheep.

Science and Geography

This month's topics are Apples, the story about Johnny Appleseed and the Fall. We will learn about the globe, water, seven continents and the world map.

Pink Towel and brown Stairs helped children understand thickness and recognize the differences in weight between sizes, as well as see the relationship and visual understanding of objects getting incrementally thinner and thicker.
