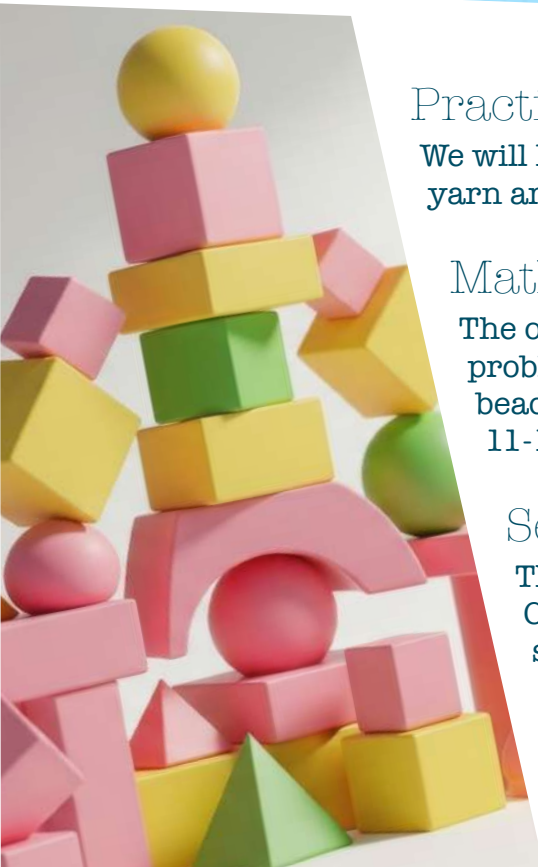

Practical Life Area

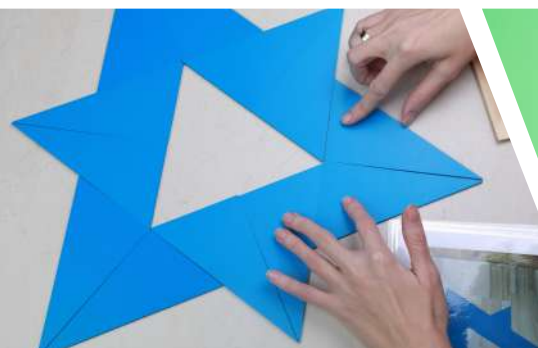
We will learn how to clean sunglasses, pour water, use tweezers and spoons, yarn art and chameleon art.

Math Area
