Language Area

We are starting a new school year and will start with ㄅ ㄆ and ㄇ (Bo, Po, Mo, and Fo). We will read the Chinese poem 三字經 (San Dz Jin) lesson 1, 浪淘沙 (Lang Tao Sha) and Chinese character strokes and tracing. The English classroom will work with the sounds for Aa, Bb, Cc, and Dd. For the older children, we will be working on the pink area, which focuses on sounding out 3 letter words. The English poem is Baa Baa Black Sheep.

Art and Music

The English songs this month are 10 Apples on My Head, Apple Round, Apple Red ; and 5 Apples Way Up High. The Chinese class will learn 我是一個大蘋果 (Wo Shi Yi Ge Da Ping Guo) 和秋天来了 (Qiu Tian Lai Le). Art will include apple stamps and apple sewing cards.

Science and Geography

This month's topics are apples, the story about Johnny Appleseed, and Fall. We will learn about Europe.

Practical Life Area

This month we will focus on how to sweep up leaves, wash our hands, and weave ribbons. We will work on transferring objects with tongs and learn how to wash apples.

Math Area

Younger children will work on recognizing and quantifying 1 to 10. We will use cards and counters, number rods, and spindles. Older children will work on recognizing and quantifying 11-19. They will use bead stairs, teen board, and will work on addition and subtraction boards with some worksheets.

Sensorial Area

Binomial and trinomial Cubes help children develop visual discrimination, concentration, and an understanding of patterns and dimensional relationships. Through hands-on exploration, children learn how individual pieces fit together to form a whole, building a concrete foundation for future mathematical and algebraic concepts.
